Upon Entry to Hong Kong – Activation of Student Visa

For All Students

If you do not activate your student visa and enter Hong Kong under a "Visitor Permit", you may not attend any classes/lectures until your "Student Visa" is activated. Otherwise, you are at risk of violating the Immigration Ordinance.

At the Immigration Counter, you must:



SHOW your Student Visa to the Immigration Officer



TELL the Immigration Officer you are entering Hong Kong as a Student



CHECK your Landing Slip and make sure you entered Hong Kong as "STUDENT"



Please **KEEP the landing slip** while remaining in Hong Kong.

When you arrive Hong Kong

UPLOAD a copy/photo of your Landing Slip (each file not exceeding 2MB in file size) immediately.

Apply for a Hong Kong Identity (HKID) Card

- **You are required to apply for a Hong Kong Identity Card at the HKSAR Immigration Department within 30 days of arrival.**
- Application can be made at any one of the **Registration of Persons Offices** of the Immigration Department. Please note that the offices only accept application submitted by electronic means.
- The appointment booking maybe made within 96 working days in advance. To facilitate the application for HKID, please make appointment booking and complete the form pre-filling online at:
